I hereby release exempt and indemnify Melbourne Rowing Club, its management committee, its sponsors and agents in respect of all liability whatsoever and however caused whether by negligence or otherwise which may arise in connection with my participation in Melbourne Rowing Club activities or external regattas and events and agree that any conditions implied by the Fair Trading Act 1999 are excluded. This release continues forever and binds my heirs, successors, executors, administrators, personal representatives and assigns.

### For Applicant under 18

If I cannot be contacted and my child should require emergency hospital treatment, I authorise a qualified medical practitioner to provide emergency treatment or medication.

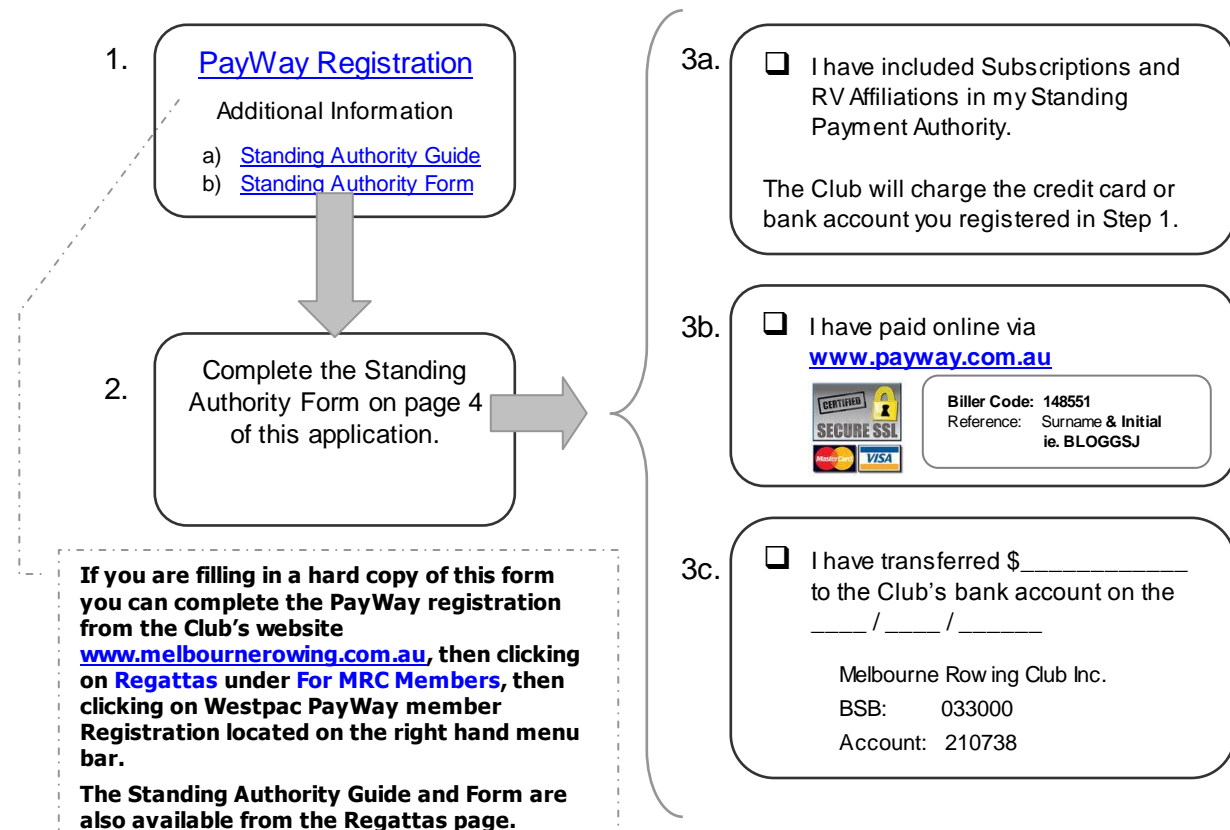

### Authorisation

You acknowledge that by registering your credit card or bank account details on Westpac's PayWay facility, and providing a Standing Payment Authority that you authorise Melbourne Rowing Club Inc (314011) to arrange through Westpac Banking Corporation Ltd a charge or debit to your nominated credit card or bank account any amount that Melbourne Rowing Club Inc (314011) has deemed payable by you. This debit or charge will be made through the Bulk Electronic Clearing System (BECS) from your account held at the financial institution you have registered and will be subject to the terms and conditions of this Standing Payment Authority and of the Direct Debit Request Service Agreement.

### Transaction Currency

All transactions are processed in Australian dollars.

### Refund Policy

The amount will be refunded in full less any bank transaction fees and amounts outstanding on your membership account. ### Security Policy

### Process Communication

Terminating your authority will prevent you from competing and storing equipment in the Club's boatshed.
